

## **Library Card Policy**

## **OBTAINING A LIBRARY CARD**

- 1. To obtain an Adult-Resident or Juvenile-Resident library card one must be a resident of the Gardiner Library service area.
- 2. Applicants must be at least 5 years old or entering kindergarten.
- 3. New Paltz residents can obtain an Adult-Resident or Juvenile-Resident library card.
- 4. Landowners, second homeowners, and business owners in the Gardiner Library service area, and employees of a local business, may obtain an Adult-Non-Resident library card. This library card entitles the user to the same privileges as an Adult-Resident library card.
- 5. Ulster County residents who live outside the library's service area and want to use the library because of convenience, place of employment, etc. can obtain an Adult-Ulster Courtesy library card which allows users to check out 10 items at a time. Adult-Ulster Courtesy card holders are not allowed to use the system's direct access.
- 6. Seasonal renters, vacationers, and visitors who are in the library's service area for four or more weeks can obtain an Adult-Temporary library card which allows the users to check out 10 items at a time. Adult-Temporary library card holders are not allowed to use the system's direct access.
- 7. Visitors (i.e., family or friends) and vacationers in the Gardiner Library service area less than four weeks can obtain an Adult-Visitor library card which allows one item to be checked out at a time and no direct access.
- 8. A library card entitles the bearer access to all sections of the library.
